III. School Athletics and Parish Athletics

- a. Should school teams by open to parish members?
 - i. Amy has many concerns with this.
 - 1. Families may be influenced to switch to public school
 - 2. May limit SFB Student participation- Concern with equity of playing time



- 3. SFB Athletic Teams are considered a marketing tool to draw new families.

- 5. Public School vs. Private School- may hold different sportsmanship standards.

IV. Administrator's Report- Amy Royes

- a. Accreditation is very time consuming for Amy.
 - i. Amy shared that the School Committee has a large role in the accreditation process and has a list of standards and benchmarks that need to be reviewed. Evidence must be provided.
 - 1. Per request from Joe Dailey, Can Amy be able to provide a high level of what is needed from the School Committee.
 - a. Amy is creating a schedule for interviews.
- b. Spirit Wear
 - i. It will be here in time for Christmas.
- c. A parent feed-back survey has been created to gain an at-home perspective as to all of the changes that have/are happening within the school.
 - Topics will include the following. Are parents feeling well informed and heard by school administration? School lunch options.

V. Sub-Committee Goals: Discussion

- a. Enrollment & Marketing, Jennifer Wells
 - i. Continuing to stabilize current enrollment
 - 1. Jennifer agrees that a family feedback survey is a great idea.
 - 2. Exploring new events to bring a sense of community to strengthen current school family bonds.
 - a. Work to build an even better school and parish relationship to allow for a complete St. Francis Borgia Community, parish and school. This will help to draw more families to enroll in the school.



- b. Fundraising/Development, Ceci Bassindale/Erika LaPean (development)
 - Oktoberfest was great. \$12,000 NET profit. Money was raised pretty equally through existing school families and existing parish members
 - ii. Very optimistic about the Auction. Looking to meet or exceed \$223,000
 - iii. Working on Goal #2- Best Practice. Establish a fundraising acct..this has not been used in the past but it is needed for various expenses.
- c. Technology, Jason Stenz
 - i. Goal #1 Assist with day to day operations.
 - 1. Cameras are taken care of by Amy
 - a. Jason is available to help Amy as needed
 - 2. Work to see if the TSR subscription service is worthwhile.
 - a. The included services need to be re-evaluated before renewal of the contract in March.
 - 3. Form a long term capital budget and schedule. Hoping to have a good fundraising year to help to resolve non profitable past year's technology budgets and forecasts.
 - ii. Goal #3- Smart Boards
 - 1. Chalks, a company that specializes in school educational technology is working with Amy to find a time to demo "smart Screens". Smart screens are significantly less expensive (\$1900 vs \$3500).
 - iii. Goal #4- Technology Plans for School
 - 1. Research some existing plans. Use what works.
- d. Finance, Joe/John
 - i. John is working to take over and learning from Joe.
